Start the **CONVERSATION, CONNECT, COMMUNICATE**, show that you **CARE**

Consider **OPTIONS, OBSERVE**, discuss, agree

Be **NEEDS** led, **NOTICE** what's important

TEAMWORK, TALKING to people, listening, engaging and **TEACHING**

ASK questions, **ADJUST** and **ADAPT** treatment plans

Be **CLINICALLY CURIOUS** - adjust, **CHALLENGE, CHANGE**
