

New Awards and Scholarships for 2020

The NZWCS is showing its support for the education of health professionals involved in wound management and rewarding the hard work by offering a range of Awards and Scholarships

The Awards comprise of:

Tissue Issue Article

- A \$100 award to a NZWCS member or a 1-year subscription to the NZWCS for a non-member for an article written and published by NZWCS in our newsletter 'Tissue Issue'. This newsletter is published 5 times per year and a list of future topics can be found at the end of the newsletter.
- Applications for this award must be received once your article has been accepted to feature in Tissue Issue and at least 2 months before the topic is featured in Tissue Issue.

Best Publication

- A \$500 award to the best article/publication in a peer review or other recognised journal. Publication/article must have been published within the year of the application for the award.
- This award is open to all members of the NZWCS. If this is a joint publication, then at least one member of the group needs to be a NZWCS member
- The award of \$500 is to be shared between all named contributors to the article.
- Applications for this award opens on 1st August with the closing date of 31st October. Award will be presented in November.

Best Runner-Up

- Depending on the number of applications received for the above award, there will be up to 3 Runner-Up awards of \$100 each.

The Scholarships comprise of:

- Three (3) awards of \$500 (per semester 1, 2 & 3) available for any Under Graduate 'Wound Management' related course. Level 6 & 7.
- One (1) award of \$1000 (per semester 1, 2 & 3) available for any post-graduate study in a 'Wound Management' related course. Level 8
- One (1) award of \$1000 per year for attendance at a national wound care related conference (not NZWCS)
- Every two (2) years Five (5) awards of 'Registration Only', for attendance at the NZWCS national conference.
- One (1) award of \$2000 for attendance at international wound care related conference.
- One (1) award of \$4000 for attendance at international wound care related conference covering all reasonable costs, but with extra special conditions.

N.B. - Applicants for all scholarships must be current Full or Corporate members of the NZWCS, have been a member for a minimum of one year at the time of application, have the support of their manager to undertake the course of study or conference and comply with all other Scholarship rules.
